

Client Alert: Elimination of FERC Form 80 and Revisions to Public Notice and Signage Requirements

On December 20, 2018, FERC issued a Final Rule eliminating the Licensed Hydropower Development Recreation Report (Form 80) that hydro licensees have heretofore been required to submit every six years, and revising requirements related to public notice and signage.
