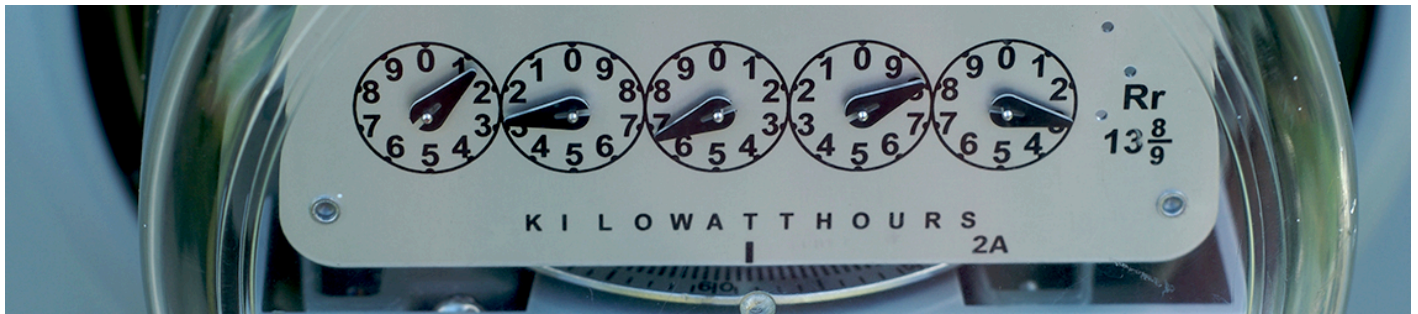


Reliability
