In one proceeding, *DATC Path 15, LLC*, Anree independently and successfully advanced a novel argument for broader refund protection for customers, resulting in a FERC initial decision that returned over \$500k to rate payers. Anree also interned at the Nuclear Energy Institute, the Department of Energy's Office of the Assistant General Counsel for Enforcement and Litigation and the Wayne County Prosecutor's Office in Michigan.

Anree brings to the energy law practice area a strong technical background, including undergraduate and graduate degrees in engineering and applied physics, and over a decade of operational and supervisory experience as a nuclear submarine officer in the U.S. Navy.
